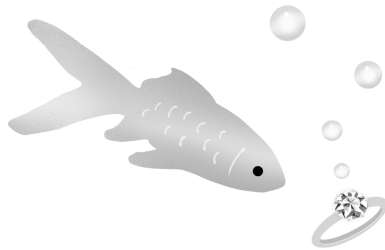

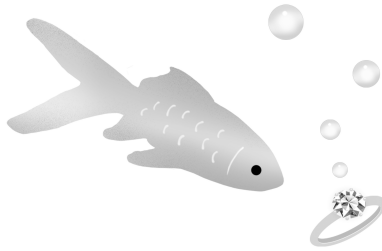

Why I Wrote This Book

My thirteen-year career as a wedding photographer provided a unique behind the scenes vantage during hundreds of weddings. It did not take long to notice that despite brilliant and ingenious wedding plans, weddings were often less predictable than the weather forecast.

That should not be too surprising since planning a wedding involves stormy clouds of variables ranging from predictable to unpredictable, heartwarming to awkward, and humorous to heart-wrenching. Most brides and grooms walk down the aisle only once in their lifetimes and do not imagine themselves blindsided by unexpected challenges. Who can imagine a simple walk down the aisle going wrong?

My hope for *Wedding Challenges!* is to entertain and inspire through fictional stories that reflect a few of the challenges I witnessed as a wedding photographer.

Initially, I wrote about potential solutions to the challenges but hit a roadblock after about a year. This approach felt impractical, since solutions depend on each reader's unique circumstances, including their ingenuity, resources, risk tolerance, personality, fortitude, and more. Solutions also

depend on the circumstances of the challenge. Further, there are an unlimited number of potential solutions to consider for any problem, they evolve over time, I can not imagine them all, and the few I know might not be the best!

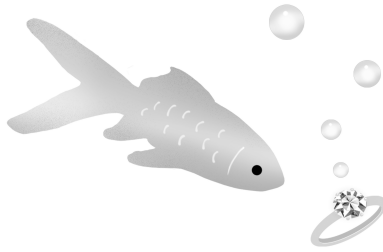
